Scholarship Detail

Two scholarships will be awarded in the spring semester to MCAT High School students. Awards will be made in the amount of \$1,000.00 per student. These scholarships will be awarded at the Marana Schools' 2340 Foundation Celebration of Excellence Luncheon to be held on March 15, 2018.

A recipient of this scholarship will have one academic year in which to spend his or her award on tuition, textbooks, educational supplies or housing for their post-secondary education.

Requirements

- Students must have been enrolled in the Marana Unified School District for the majority of the K-12 experience, having not missed more than a full semester or earned more than 1.5 credits outside the Marana Unified School District, and must complete their senior year in a Marana Unified School District High School.
- Students must provide high school transcripts.
- List all financial aid or scholarships obtained for your post-secondary education.
- Two letters of recommendation
- Be willing to come back in the Fall of 2017 and share their experience with other students.
- Provide a narrative separately addressing these questions:
 - What do you value most about graduating from a Marana school? If applicable include- Describe the circumstances under which you left the Marana Unified School District. What did you learn from this experience? (500 words or less)
 - Where do you plan on going to school after you graduate? Describe how receiving this scholarship would impact your ability to pursue these goals. (500 words or less)
 - What are the obstacles that were in your path to success? How did you keep education a priority with overcoming these challenges? (500 words or less)
 - How did nontraditional school programs or courses in Marana Unified School District benefit your progress? (500 words or less)

Deadline

Scholarship applications will be due on **January 12, 2018** for the 2018 award. Scholarship applications should be submitted to MCAT Counseling Office.
